


Creators submitting must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Certify their musical theatre work aligns with MTEA's mission statement and Code of Ethics
- Provide details about their musical theatre work via the questionnaire (e.g. cast size, band size, etc.)
- Provide a link (Google Drive or Dropbox) to a folder containing the following materials:
 - 3 demo song MP3s
 - 20-30 consecutive pages of libretto (pdf)
 - Cast breakdown with vocal ranges (pdf)
 - Synopsis of the musical work 200 words or fewer (pdf)
 - Bios for writers/creators 1 page (pdf)
 - Developmental history 1 page (pdf)
