How does Pay What You Decide work?

Tickets are available to reserve in advance as usual, but the opportunity to pay occurs after you have seen the show. You decide how much to pay!

Is there a minimum ticket price?

Nope! The price is completely up to you!

What does the money support?

All money collected helps pay our artists, support future productions, and open the doors for others to experience our work! Therefore we hope you will give generously.

So, how do I get my tickets?

There are no physical tickets! Once you've made your reservation, a confirmation will be emailed to you. No need to print anything out - simply show up for your selected performance and check in at the box office.

How do I pay?

Payment can be made after the performance by cash, check or credit card. We provide a payment envelope in your program or you can visit us at the box office to make your payment.

Are there still discounts for Students, Industry Members and Seniors?

Now that you have the opportunity to pay what you decide based on your experience, this model eliminates the need for reduced price, discounted or tiered ticketing, providing an equal opportunity for patrons from any financial background.

Is my payment anonymous?
