## roles of targets of oppression organizing for equity and justice:

- 1. to move beyond merely challenging individuals to focus their efforts on organizational, institutional and structural transformation by targeting policies, practices, and procedures to create equity.
- 2. to organize and educate other targets in order to provide accountable leadership for movements working towards equity and justice.
- 3. to heal from and be held accountable by other targets for manifestations of internalized inferiority.
- 4. to utilize agents as allies, providing leadership and accountability.
- 5. to be accountable to a strategy & vision of equity and justice.

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## being a strategic ally for equity and justice:

a member of a dominant/privileged group in our society who works to dismantle any form of oppression from which they receive the benefit.
